



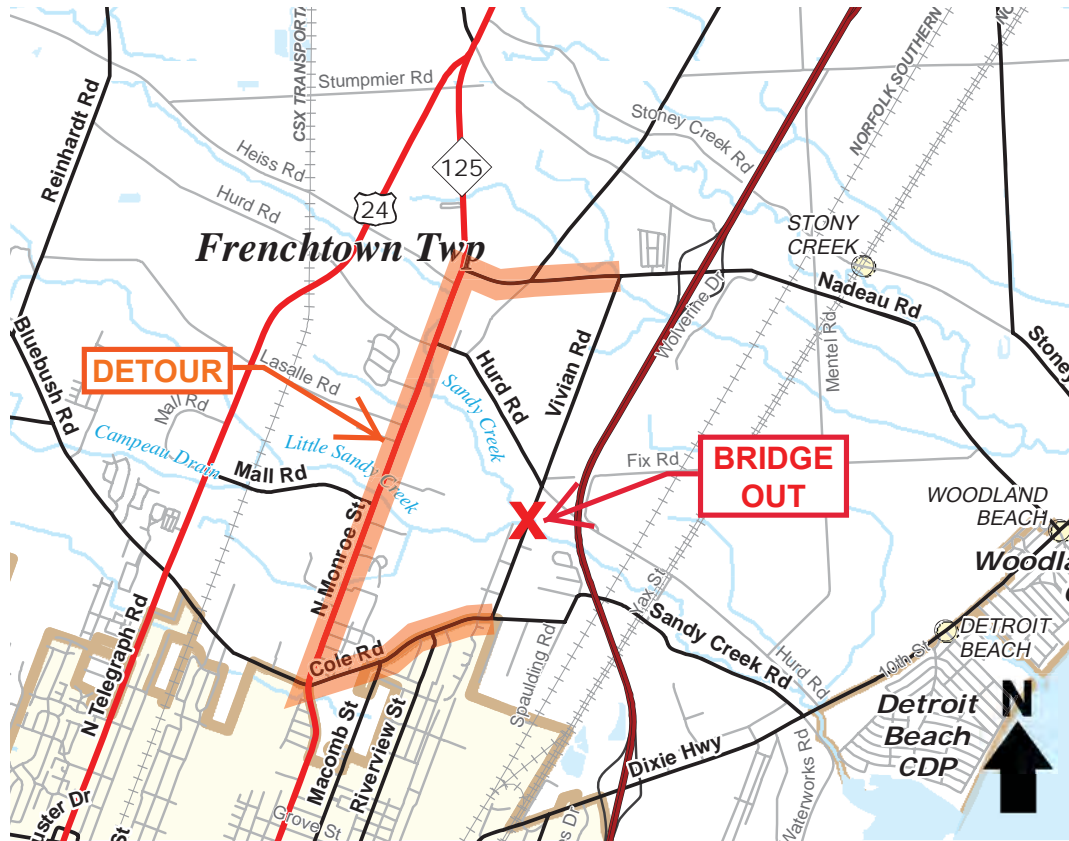

When Will This Be Done?

This work will begin July 23, 2018 and is expected to take approximately 2 months to complete.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

This work will require a complete closure of Vivian Road at the bridge through July and August with a tentative opening date of August 31st and completion in early October 2018. There will be a signed detour around the closed bridge via Cole Road, North Monroe Street (M-125) and Nadeau Road.
